\* James Comstock served as Probate Judge by virtue of appointment, during this time, also, William B. Blain held through the May term of 1839, and Clement B. Simonson held through the August term of 1843, by virtue of commissions. The office of Probate Judge terminated October 1, 1852, being then changed by the new Constitution to Common Pleas Judges; the latter being abolished in 1873, after which the business thereof was transferred to the Circuit Court.

† Richard H. Lansdale resigned both as Clerk and Auditor, May 11, 1840; George R. Thralls serving by appointment in his stead, from May 13, 1840, till the following September. W. C. Graves was then elected, August 3, 1840, and served till August 1, 1842, to fill the unexpired term of Lansdale. Being re-elected as Clerk, he resigned January 22, 1848, Samuel H. Chipman being appointed till the following August, when he was elected for one year to fill the yet unexpired term of W. C. Graves.

‡ The County Commissioners appointed this officer annually at their March term, until the year 1841, when Mahlon F. Davis was elected; he died in office January 8, 1849. William Williams was appointed to fill vacancy till August election following, when he was re-elected. George Moon elected for a term of two years, under the new Constitution. In 1862, Nelson Baker having been re-elected, died in office, April 2, 1864, and Joseph A. Funk appointed to fill vacancy, serving to November 1, following. Samuel M. Hayes died in office, January 18, 1876, and William B. Funk appointed January 21, 1876, to fill vacancy, until October election following.

§ Ludlow Nye died February, 1846, Daniel Shoup being appointed and qualified March 16, following, to fill the vacancy. William Biggs died January, 1855, Washington McGrew being appointed to fill the vacancy. James H. Cisney held over one year, from 1869 to 1870, by reason of the law changing elections from annual to biennial.

|| Jonah Hacker removed from county, W. B. Boydston being appointed to fill vacancy, and qualified March 15, 1858. There was a vacancy in this office of one year, from 1862 to 1863. Vacancy one year, from 1869 to 1870.

¶ James M. Defrees died in office. James H. Schell was appointed to fill the vacancy.

\*\* James McGrew died May, 1872, and Leigh H. Hammond was appointed to fill the vacancy.
