JOHN BLUE (BREW) and his wife Cattren (Catherine) were born
in Scotland, and with their children came to New Jersey,
U. S. A. In 1726 they moved to Hampshire County, Virginia.
Their son John was 12 years of age at that time.

The Will of John Blue was dated in July 1770, and was
Probated August 14th, 1770 in the Clerk's Office of
Hampshire County, Virginia, a portion of which is as follows:

- 1st - To son John - - - - Best suit of clothes and other
wearing apparel.
- 2nd - " " Michael - - - - Breasted coat and silver spoons.
- 3rd - " " Uriah - - - - Silver spoons.
- 4th - " " Abraham - - - - Two horses, saddle, wagon gears,
plow, irons, ax and wedge.
- 5th - " " Cattren Blue - The remainder of the personal
estate for life, with remainder
thereof to son Abraham.
