He served in the Hampshire County Va
military during the Revolutionary War,
and was later known as Captain John Blue
Born in 1742; died August 21 - 1821,
in Fayette County, Ohio and is buried in
Huntingburgh Cemetery.

He served in the Revolutionary War.
Born in 1745; died in 1814.

Both are buried in an old cemetery near
New Holland, Ohio, in Pickaway County.
Will Book B page 33 at Washington Court House
Fayette County, Ohio, shows his Will made
March 29 - 1842. (Probated June 1842)

It mentions his wife Susannah; his sons
John, Abraham, Peter, Jr., Isaac Jacob,
Benjamin, David, William and Phillip;
three daughters, Margaret Crabb, Alice
Wilcox and Susannah David.

The Pension Bureau shows his widow applied
for a pension on August 1-1856, at which
time she was 89 years old. She alleged
Peter Blue enlisted in Hampshire County,
Virginia about May 1-1781 and served in
Captain Anderson's Virginia Company, and
was at the siege of Yorktown. He was
discharged November 1-1781.
