

Comments on your history of Blue family.

pg 12a. Every body seems to think we belong to the United family. All what you say. Frankly, I do not think we belong on this side. Grandpa Roland Blue seems a family history of his relatives to my sister and in at least 100 years of Scotch descent. Father's descendants are Scotch and Swann's folk - some Scotch and German, mostly Scotch. His grand father Peter lived to be 90, Swann's 99. One "Book" record, I found, named only 13 children - no Peter in John Blue's list of children. Will give 14. (He to get 140)

Will found a Will in W.V. 1756 of an older John Blue. He had silver spoons, books or tokens etc as well as negro man and negro woman listed in the list of his estate. Lists the family's names. One a "Fletcher". A Thomas Buckley of London O has listed a Frederick Blue & Mary 1st wife she born 1709 - and Jane Nevius (Nevius) second wife, married in Aug 22, 1751. She born Dec 25, 1700 d - Oct 3, 1782 age 60 yrs old. By first marriage 9 children - by second the Peter's 1st wife she first of her son. Isaac Elizabeth & David. Isaac the Rev. was record. 1752 + 90 years = 1842 years of Peter's death according to Peter Will in Fayette Co. O.

Note - Marion township, Fayette Co. Peter Blue native of Va. emigrated from that state 1815. Located on land now owned by Smith Chaffin. Excellent citizen and his death which occurred in 1848 was deeply deplored by the entire community. "History of Fayette Co. Ohio"
