Going farther back into the history of the Blue family my great grandfather's name was Peter Kaiser Blue and his wife's maiden name was Susan Kelch who was born in Holland, they were the parents of eleven children, eight sone and three daughters, the daughters were Aice who married William Wilcox both of whom are buried in the Mentone cemetery, Susannah who married a man by the name of Davis and Margaret who married a man by the name of Crab I dont know anything about the whereabout of the two latter families, the sons were John P. the eldest Abraham, Peter , Jacob, David, Benjamin, William and Philip, the four latter were the youngest in their regular
