Dear Mr Bryant:- Your letter of inquiry concerning the history of your grandmother, Susan Blue, Bybee, was received several days ago . Your great grandfather Abraham Blue married a widow whose maiden name was Youngs she was married to one Samuel Lindsey and they had one child Hannah and Mr Lindsey died and she married Blue and they had six children that grew to manhood and womanhood, two sons Rhesa and Peter and four daughters, Sarah, who married Albert Tucker, Jane who married Regulus Tucker, Elisabeth who married Nelson Doran and your grandmother Susan.

Going farther back into the history of the Blue family my great grandfather's name was Peter Kaiser Blue and his wife's maiden name was Susan Kelch who was born in Holland , they were the parents of eleven children, eight sons and three daughters, the daughters were Aice who married William Wilcox both of whom are buried in the Mentone cemetery, Susannah who married a man by the name of Davis and Margaret who married a man by the name of Crab I dont know anything about the whereabouts of the two latter families, the sons were John P. the eldest Abraham, Peter , Jacob, David, Benjamin, William and Philip, the four latter were the youngest in their regular
