

## READ CAREFULLY

**HEALTH OFFICER:** This burial-transit permit may be issued only upon receipt of a death certificate.

**FUNERAL DIRECTORS:** This burial-transit permit is required for any manner of disposition of a dead body including interment, storage, cremation and **transportation**. A permit is required for each stillbirth before disposal of the body.

When used as a transit permit for transportation by common carrier this permit, or a duplicate thereof, should be enclosed in a strong envelope and attached to the shipping case.

Before shipment by train or express, the body must be embalmed; or if that is not practicable, must be enclosed in a tightly sealed casket or outer case.

**SEXTON:** It is unlawful for any sexton, or other person in charge of a burial place, to permit burial or other disposition of a dead body before a burial-transit permit is deposited with him.
