

Indiana National Poultry Improvement Plan Participation

The following is an alphabetical listing of those organizations who have signed agreements to participate under the standards of the National Poultry Improvement Plan. In Indiana the birds have been inspected and accepted.

During the 1946 season the following Indiana Standards are in force: Pullorum-Tested—over the 45 weeks; Pullorum-Controlled—over their 520 weeks; Pullorum-Tested—no chick hatch; new participants will have 25% of their chicks inspected and stock tested. Any interested party wishing to check upon the status of a participant should write L. A. Wilson, Executive Director and Indiana NPIP Administrator, State Poultry Association of Indiana, Inc., LaPorte, Indiana.
