3. That you will also prepare complete working drawings.
4. That you will keep the matter confidential until I have protected it by patents.
5. That in consideration of your best and diligent efforts in the foregoing I will give you five percent (5%) of whatever net sum I realize out of the invention.
6. That the engineering work applies to the experimental form only lighter.
