April 15, 1949 – Oct. 6, 2019

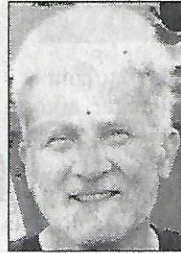
Timmy Barton, 70, Mentone, passed away peacefully in his home surrounded by his loving family at 11:45 a.m. Oct. 6, 2019.
