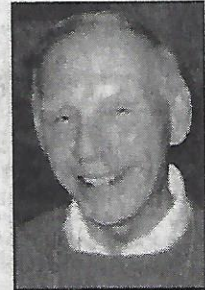
He was preceded in death by his parents, Harold and Esther Markley.
