### RULES GOVERNING EXHIBITS

- 1.—All animals must be on Fair Grounds not later than 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, August 24th. Entries will not be accepted after that hour.
- 2.—The Committees will appreciate exhibitors making known the number of animals they will exhibit. This may be done by contacting the Committees in charge of the various Departments. Exhibitors in the Horse Department may phone or mail entries to O. A. Heighway, Akron, R. G. Reed, Mentone or Leroy Norris, Mentone. Notify not later than August 20th.
- 3.—Straw for bedding will be furnished free to all livestock exhibitors.
- 4.—Hay will be for sale on grounds at a reasonable price.
- 5.—All exhibits will be given adequate police protection.
- 6.—Attractive cards giving name and age of the animal and the name and address of the exhibitor will be furnished at 5c each.
- 7.—All animals will be released at 4:00 p. m. Saturday, August 27th.
- 8.—All animals must be taken to show ring promptly when called for.
- 9.—Stables must be kept clean and attractive at all times.
- 10.—Exhibitors must place animals in stalls or pens assigned them by the officers of the Association.
- 11.—The exhibitor must show the certificate of registry for all registered animals. All animals shown in Purebred classes one year and over must be registered and the certificate of registry shown at the time of entry.
- 12.—The judges' decision will be final in all cases.
- 13.—The Association reserves the right to remove from the grounds all sick animals.
- 14.—Any question or misunderstanding should be referred to the superintendent of your department.
