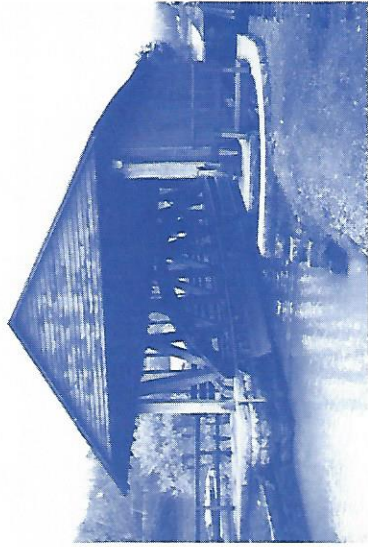

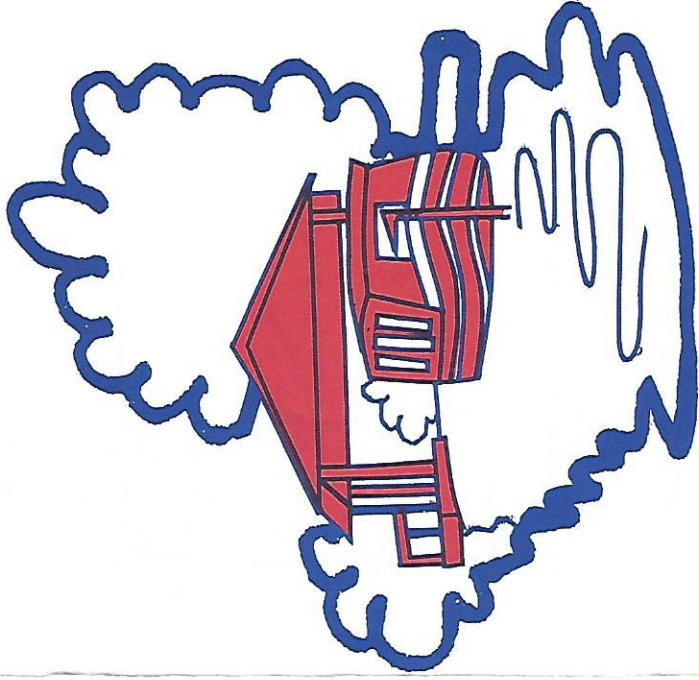
History...

In 1836, construction was begun on the Whitewater Canal, it stretched 76 miles from Hagerstown through Metamora, to Lawrenceburg and was operated by 56 locks and 7 feeder dams. The Metamora Aqueduct was added in 1843 to carry canal water 16 feet over Duck Creek.



Never economically successful it was replaced by the railroad and the automobile. U.S. 52 running through Metamora, was the main route from Cincinnati to Indianapolis. In the 1930's, passenger train service was discontinued and U.S. 52 was relocated to by-pass the village, leaving it isolated until 1946 when the State acquired 14 miles of the canal and began restoration. The "Valley Belle" canal boat began operating in 1966, the Grist Mill Museum was dedicated in 1973, and railroad passenger service restored in 1974.

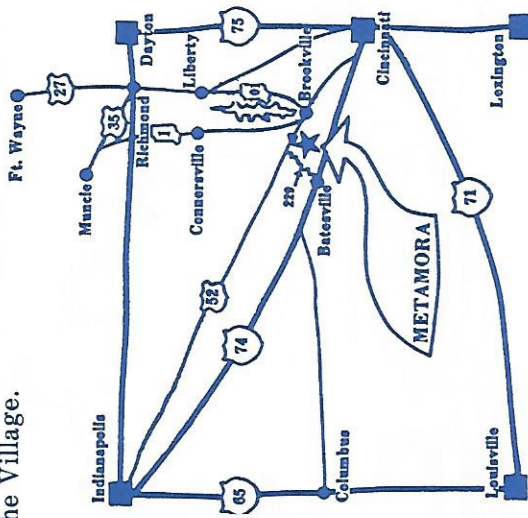

excursions are available at Old Metamora. The old buildings in the town, and many recon-

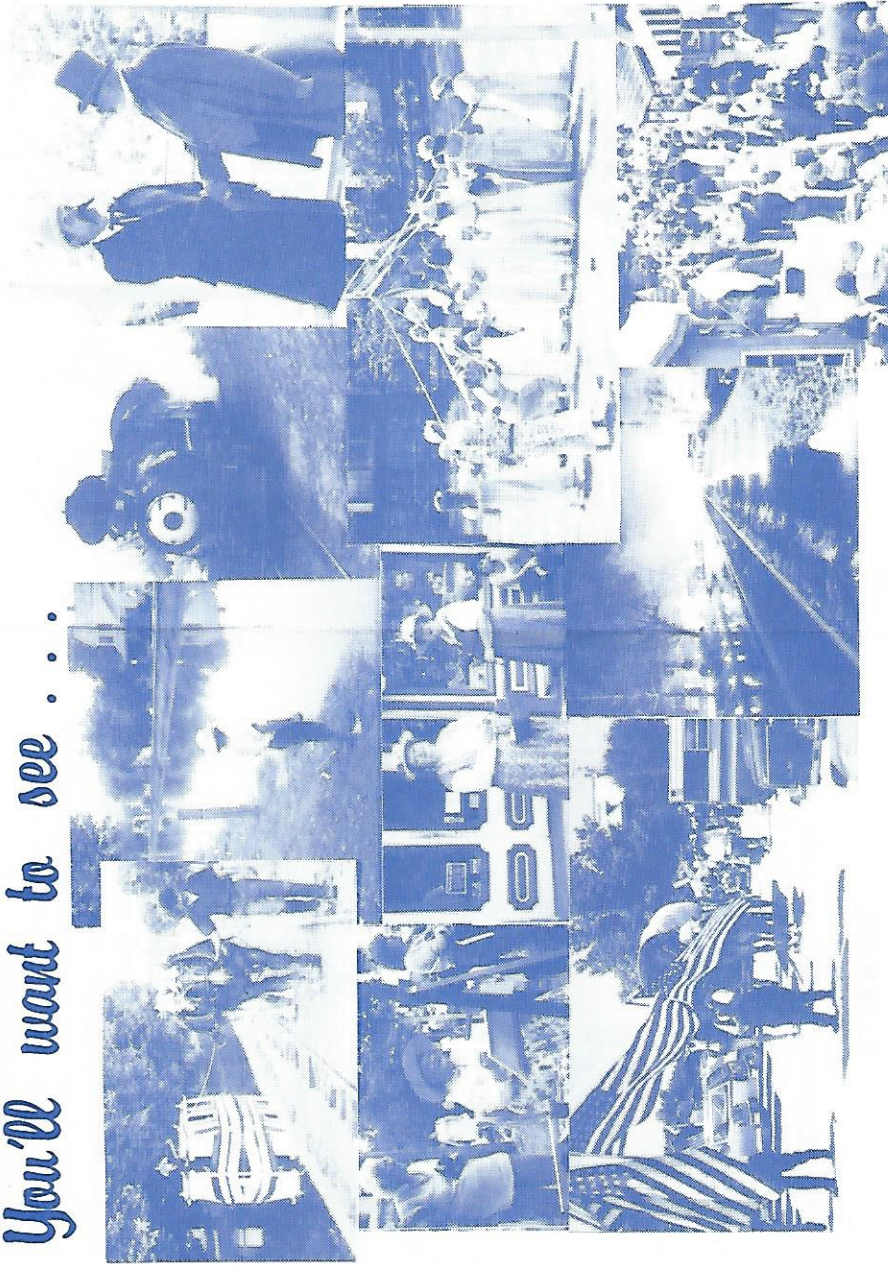

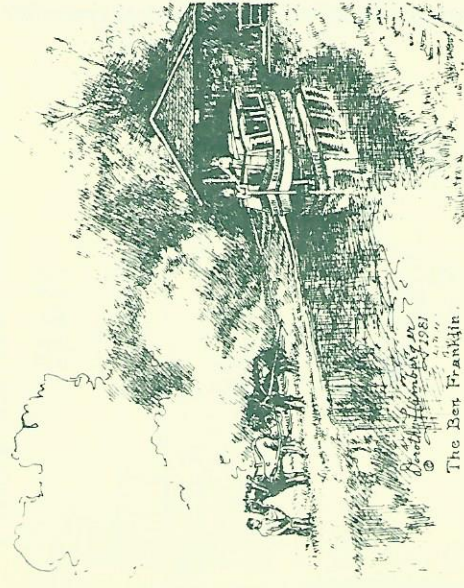

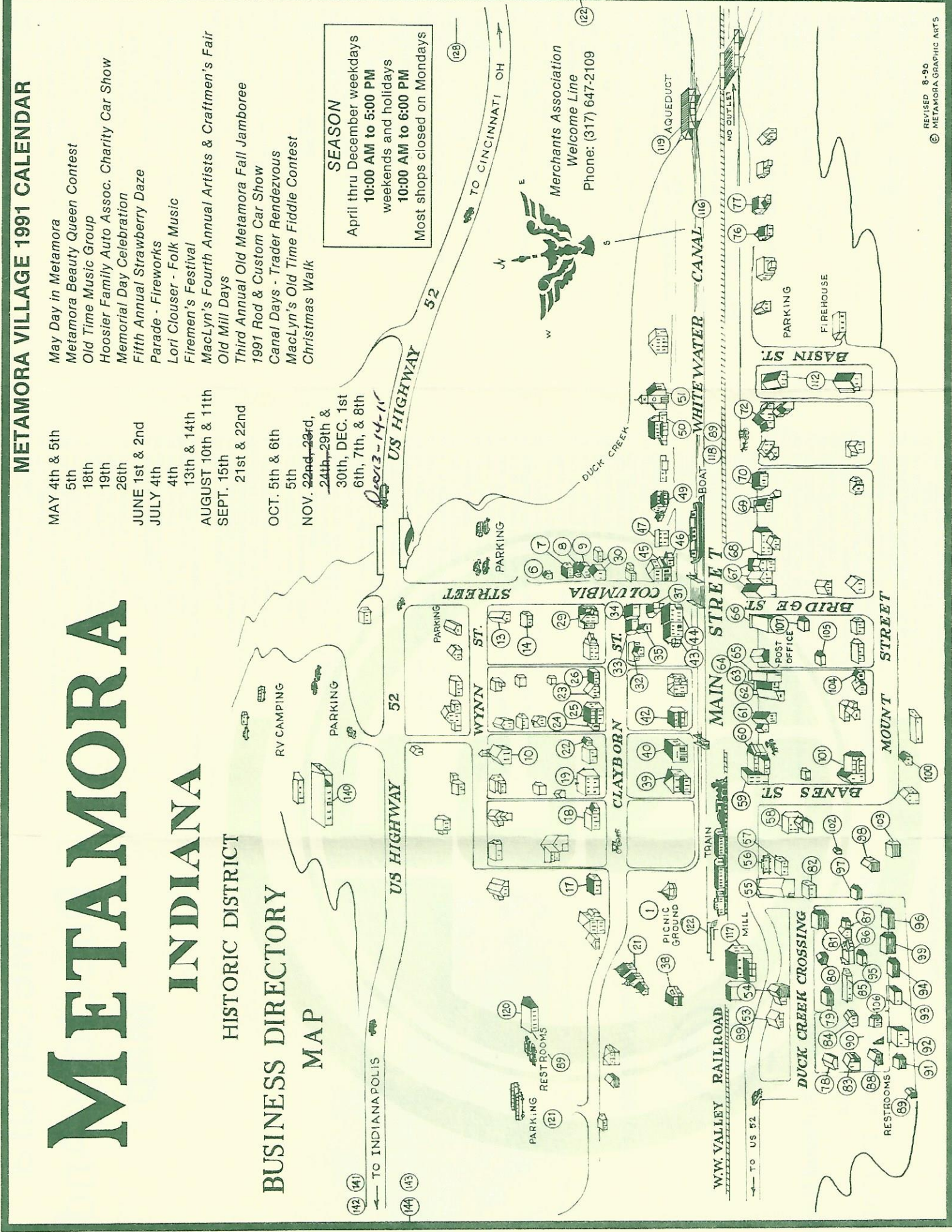

The State operates the Old Grist Mill and a canal boat that runs through the middle of town, through the only wooden covered aqueduct operating in the United States, and finally through the locks at the east end of town. The Whitewater Railroad provides old train rides from Connersville, through the valley along the canal to Metamora. You may stroll or ride a horse drawn carriage through the shady streets and take in the more than 100 arts, crafts and specialty shops.

Metamora is located 8 miles west of Brookville, Indiana on U.S. Highway 52 less than an hour from Cincinnati less than two hours from Indianapolis. The enclosed information is designed to help you make the most of the time you will spend with us, whether an hour or a day.

Some visitors prefer to see the village on their own, enjoying the scenery, resting in the gazebo, or feeding the ducks along the canal. To plan a group tour of the grist mill or canal boat ride, please contact the Whitewater Canal Historic Site, (317) 647-6512. For more information on a steam engine excursion, call Whitewater Valley Railroad at (317) 825-2054. Reservations for group dining should be made in advance by calling the restaurant of your choice.


