- Feb 6, 1922 Furchased a 1922 Ford 1 ton trk., water system being chemical at a sum of \$2200.00 and an ordinance was made for this chemical fire truck.
- Feb 7, 1930 Signed contract to buy Boyer Fire Truck at the cost of \$1500.00.

  A fee of \$25.00 per run to non subscribers in rural community was set.

  (This truck was kept and is now used in parades.) The 1922 Boyer Truck is shown how it looked in 1940 and now how it looks.)
  - July 9, 1965 The Fire Department is now governed by the Mentone-Tri-Township Fire Control Board which included Mentone and three townships, Harrison, Franklin and Newcastle.
