When planning a visit to New Harmony, call in advance to arrange for group tours. The New Harmony Visitor Center provides information on lodging, dining and camping facilities.



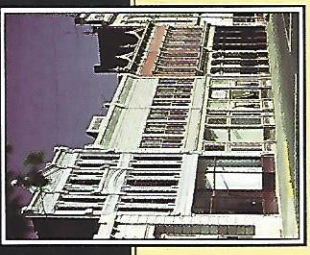
Historic New Harmony is located on the banks of the Wabash River at the intersection of Indiana Routes 66 and 68, seven miles south of Interstate 64. From Interstate 64 in Indiana, take the Poseyville exit; in Illinois, take the Grayville exit.

In 1814, Father Rapp and the Harmonie Society settled what is now New Harmony. In ten short years, they created a flourishing, self-sufficient community, known as "that Wonder of the West."

In 1824, the Harmonists sold the entire town to Welsh-born social reformer Robert Owen and philanthropist William Maclure who gathered scholars, scientists and educators and brought them to New Harmony. The results of their labors and intellect can be seen in the hundreds of scholarly books, artifacts, experiments, and social and scientific advancements throughout the midwest and the nation.

Today, New Harmony remains a cultural and educational center. Great care has been taken to restore buildings and grounds to their original state. But New Harmony is much more than a historical center. Visitors from all over the world come to see the work of the century's foremost architects and to enjoy the quiet elegance of past and present intertwined.
