

a Dr Lane, dentist in the old brick
building, directly north across the street.

he were great old fishing friends). He took
Wednesday off and we Edith & I spent
most every summer in Mentone, visiting
his folks Mills, and my folks Gunlips.
So we fished that day.

3. Next to that at that time there were two vacant lots just west of the old brick. The old post office was next to Daalgewa's stove east of the alley. I think Carl Meyer built the cement block bldgs east of the old store in about 1905 or so.



I don't know ^{MS} church to Cemetery who or when the building on the vacant lot was built but I do know the library was there & should have made a better drawing. Let's go back a little further.

John attorney with Frank Government, Next
the P.O. Mr Miller postmaster then on corner
#3 saw other places. I could go on and
and on about Mentone after 1905. We are
entire housed in the building now where
Frank & Jerry's store. The lower part was a
shop, had was a boulder, being about
Mentone about the inconvenience before
water and sewer about 1910-11.
