

## Bell Librarian Named Area President

Madeleine Fisher, the director of Bell Memorial Public Library in Mentone, was named on Sept. 17 as the president of ALSA 2 (Area 2 Library Services Authority) at a meeting at the University Club on the Notre Dame campus.

Mrs. Fisher, the director of the Bell Memorial Public Library for more than 10 years, succeeds Notre Dame University Library Director Robert Miller as ALSA 2 president.

She has worked as a member of the executive board the last three years and has been vice president under Miller for two terms.

Mrs. Fisher said her being named as ALSA 2 president did not come as a surprise, except for having a small library being given a position of power.

Area 2 represents a four-county

area of Elkhart, St. Joseph, Marshall and Kosciusko and includes in that area all large academic university-type libraries and special libraries such as those of Miles Laboratory and St. Joseph Memorial Hospital.

Mrs. Fisher says the Mentone library is able to tap into specialized medical material of those type of libraries, which is a great help considering the library works with a frozen levy and the prices of books continues to climb.
