

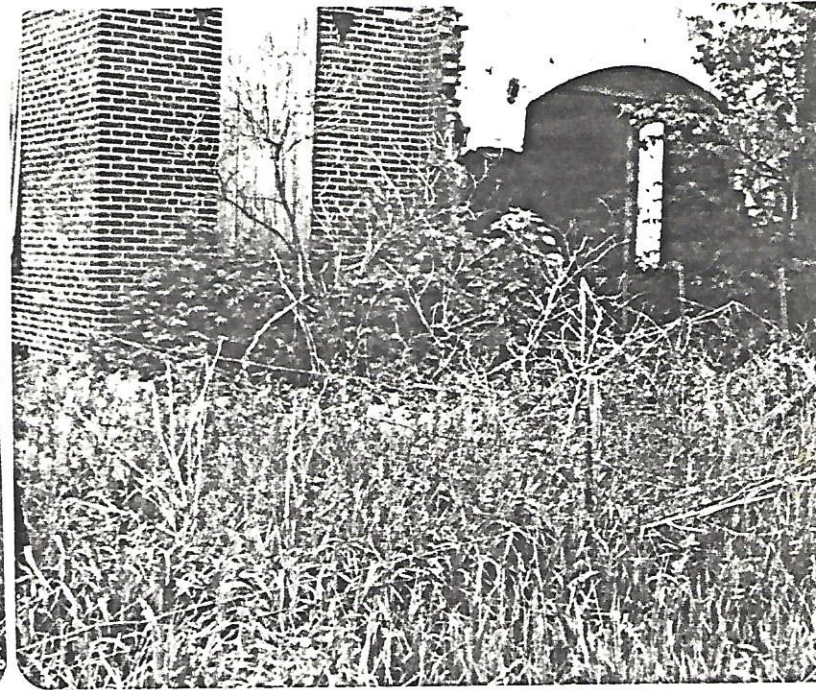
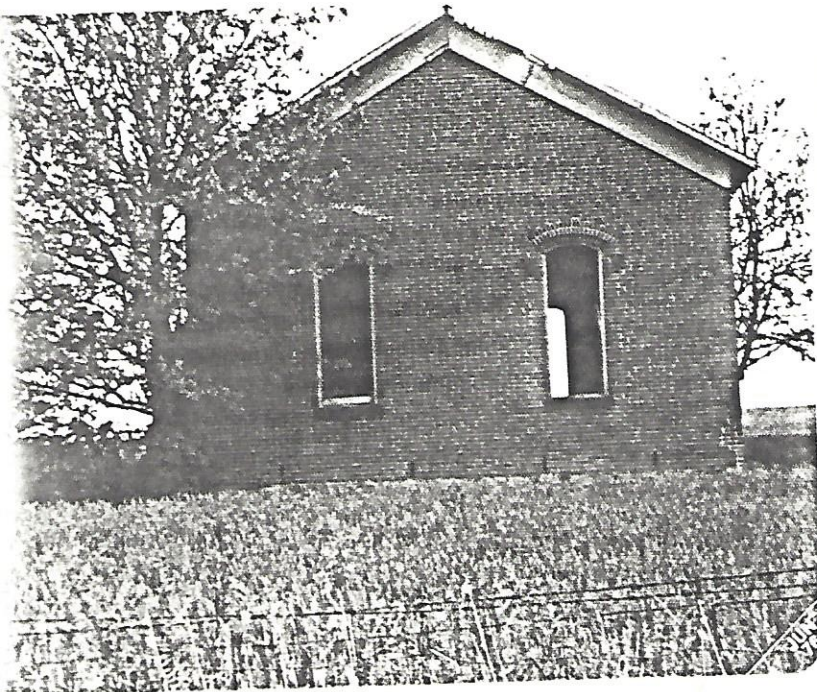


The above school picture was taken in 1895, and was brought in by Eba Bayne, who was in the fourth grade at the time.
