



But most of all, changing who we are. As another year passed, we all changed into different, more intelligent people.




One thing that is never in short supply at TVHS is school spirit.














Homecoming Spirit Week
















Homecoming Olympics

Friday afternoon of homecoming week means only one thing: the olympics.



















TVHS Drama Takes on NYC






Grease


A Night to Remember


