Fast Facts About Four-Leaf Clovers

There are approximately 10,000 three-leaf clovers for every "lucky" four-leaf clover.

There are no clover plants that naturally produce four leaves, which is why four-leaf clovers are so rare.

The leaves of four-leaf clovers are said to stand for faith, hope, love, and luck.

It's often said that Ireland is home to more four-leaf clovers than any other place, giving meaning to the phrase "the luck of the Irish."

If you're lucky enough to find a four-leaf clover, look for more!

If a clover plant produces a four-leaf clover, it's more likely to produce another four-leaf lucky charm than plants that only produce three-leaf clovers.

The fourth leaf can be smaller or a different shade of green than the other three leaves

Shamrocks and four-leaf clovers are not the same thing; the word 'shamrock' refers only to a clover with three leaves.

Recipe:

Lemon-Butter New Potatoes



Prep/Total Time: 30 min. Makes 4 servings

Ingredients

12 small red potatoes

1/3 cup butter, cubed

3 tablespoons lemon juice

1 teaspoon salt

1 teaspoon grated lemon peel

1/4 teaspoon pepper

1/8 teaspoon ground nutmeg

2 tablespoons minced fresh parsley



Directions

Peel a strip from around each potato. Place potatoes in a large saucepan and cover with water. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat; cover and cook for 15-20 minutes or just until tender.

Meanwhile, in small saucepan, melt butter. Stir in the lemon juice, salt, lemon peel, pepper and nutmeg. Drain potatoes and place in a serving bowl. Pour butter mixture over potatoes; toss
