
#### Ingredients:

- 1 Crust from box refrigerated Pillsbury Pie Crusts (2 count), soften as directed.
- 1 Package (8oz) cream cheese softened.
- 4 Eggs. 3/4 cup sugar. 2 teaspoons vanilla. 1/4 teaspoon salt.
- 1 1/4 cups chopped pecans. 1 cup light corn syrup. Whipped cream, if desired. Ground cinnamon, if desired.
- 1. Heat oven to 350°. Place pie crust in 9-inch pie plate as directed on box.
- 2. In medium bowl, beat cream cheese, 1 of the eggs, 1/2 cup of sugar, 1 teaspoon of the vanilla and the salt with electric mixer on medium speed until smooth. Pour mixture into crust-lined plate; sprinkle evenly with chopped pecans.
- 3. In large bowl, beat corn syrup and remaining 3 eggs, 1/4 cup sugar and 1 teaspoon vanilla with whisk. Pour over pecans. Place plate on cookie sheet.
- 4. Bake on lowest oven rack 50 to 55 minutes or until set. Cool completely on cooling rack, about 1 hour. Serve or refrigerate. Top individual servings with whipped cream and cinnamon. Store covered in refrigerator up to 2 days.









