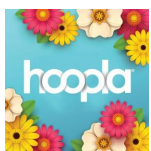

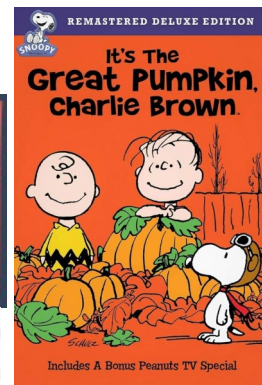

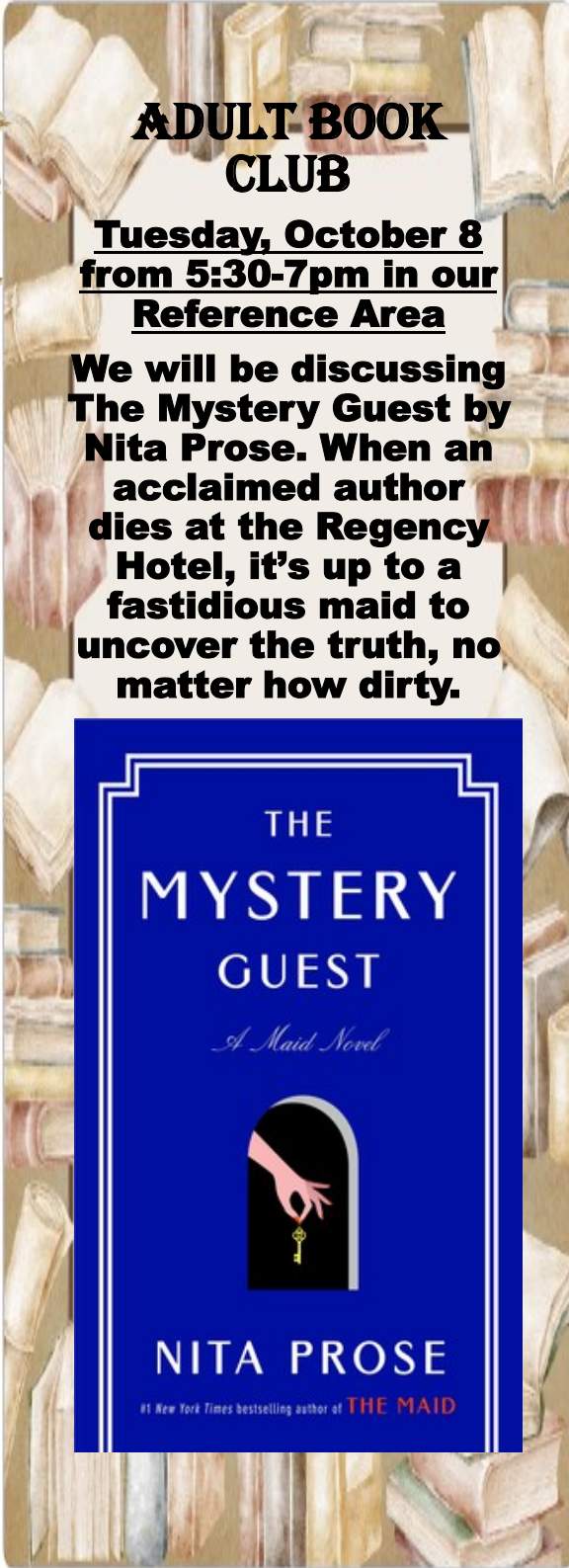

MOVIE MONDAY

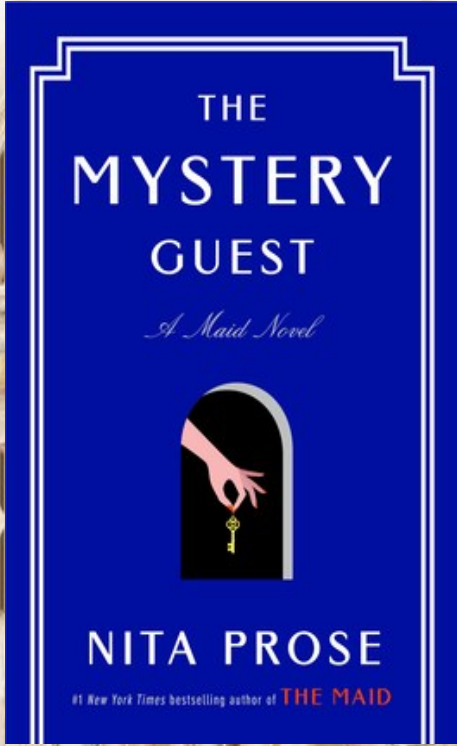

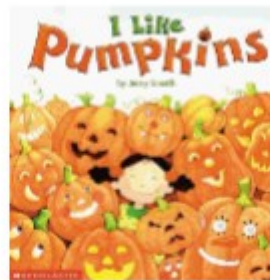

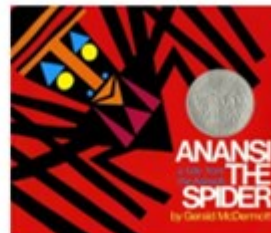

Spooky Brownies



Ingredients: 1 Box
16oz Betty Crocker
Delights Supreme
Original Brownie Mix.
Water, vegetable oil
and egg called for on
brownie mix box.

1 Cup Betty Crocker
Rich & Creamy white
frosting

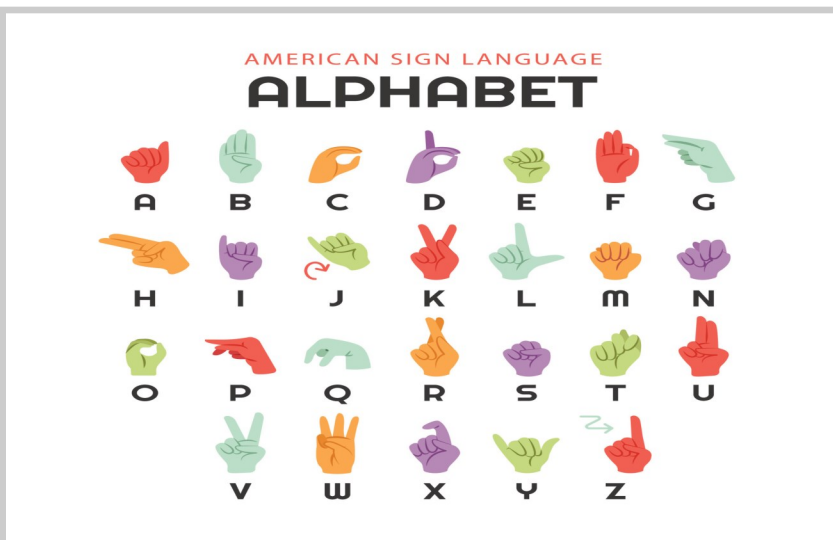
16 large
marshmallows

1. Heat oven to 350°. Line 8 or 9 inch square pan with foil, allowing some to hang over the edges of pan. Grease bottom and sides of foil with shortening or cooking spray. Make and bake brownies as directed on box. Cool completely, remove brownies from pan and cut into 4 rows by 4 rows.
2. Heat frosting in microwaveable bowl covered on high for 20 to 30 seconds until frosting can be stirred smooth and fluid.
3. Top each brownie with 1 large marshmallow. Spoon 1 tablespoon frosting over each marshmallow. Let stand until frosting is set, about 30 minutes. Use black gel to make eyes and mouths.
