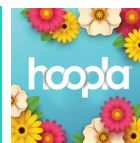
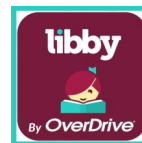

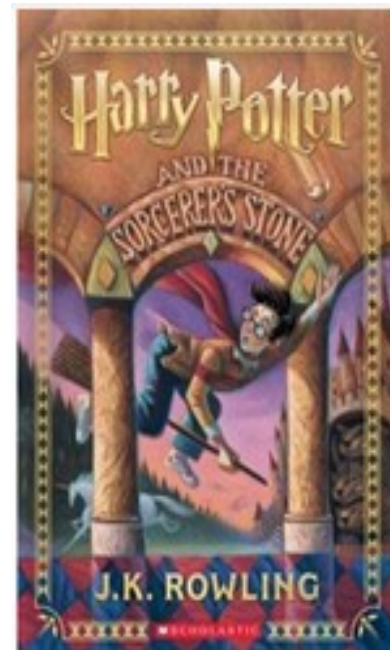


## **Adult Book Club**

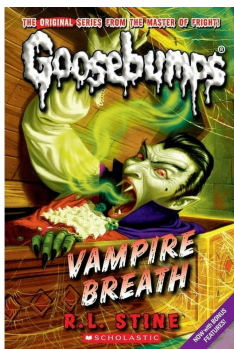

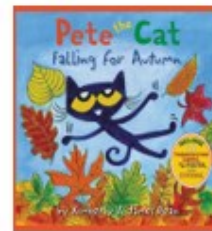

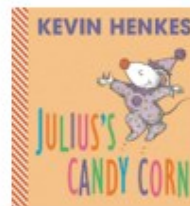

# Candy Corn Cupcake Trifles



- 1 box Betty Crocker Super Moist Vanilla Cake Mix, water, vegetable oil and eggs called for on the cake mix box
- 1/2 teaspoon orange paste food color
- 1/4 teaspoon yellow paste food color
- 12 mason jars 8 oz or other half pint jars
- 2 tubs Betty Crocker Whipped Fluffy White Frosting
- 1 & 1/2 cups candy corn

1. Heat oven to 350°F. Place paper baking cup in each of the 24 regular size muffin cups. Make cake mix as directed on the box, using water, oil, and eggs. Divide batter in half; tint half batter orange and the other half yellow. Divide each color batter evenly among muffin cups.
2. Bake 18-20 minutes or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool 10 minutes; remove cupcakes from pans to cooling racks. Cool completely.
3. Remove paper baking cups. Cut each cupcake in half horizontally. In each jar, place 1 yellow cupcake half and 1 orange cupcake half. Spoon 1 container of frosting into 1-gallon resealable food-storage bag; seal bag. Cut off 1/2 inch corner of bag. Twist bag above frosting; squeeze bag to pip frosting over orange cupcake in each jar. Sprinkle evenly 1 cup of candy corn. Repeat layers with remaining cupcake halves, second container of frosting and remaining 1/2 cup candy corn.

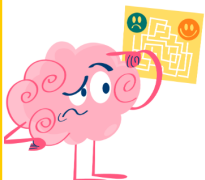
