your stuffed animal. Come back by 7pm Wednesday, June 24 to find out what mischief the animals got into overnight at the library!

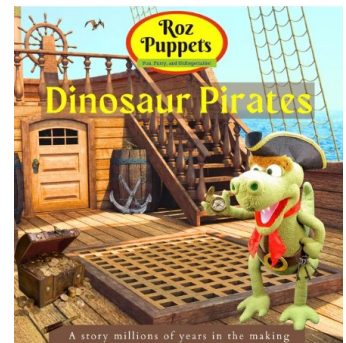

The Land that Time Forgot

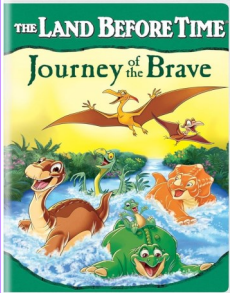
Thursday, June 11 at 1pm in the Large Conf. Rm. (1974 Rated PG)

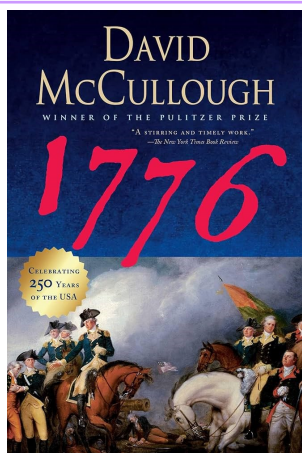
Pina Colada Fruit Salad

- 1/3 cup non-alcoholic pina colada mix
- 1/3 cup pineapple juice
- 1/2 teaspoon coconut extract
- 2 cups fresh pineapple, cubed
- 1/2 cup green grapes, halved
- 1/2 cup red grapes, halved
- 1/2 cup blueberries
- 1/2 cup raspberries
- 1/2 cup blackberries
- 10 strawberries, quartered
- 2 cutie oranges, peeled and sectioned.



1. Make the sauce. Whisk together the pina colada mix, pineapple juice and coconut extract. Set aside.
2. Assemble the salad. Toss together the pineapple, grapes, blueberries, raspberries, blackberries, strawberries, and cuties in a large bowl. Drizzle the sauce over the fruit and gently toss to coat fruit evenly.

3. Serve.
