# Shamrock Shakes



- ◆ 3 Cups vanilla bean ice cream
- ◆ 1 1/2 cups whole milk
- ◆ 1 1/2 tsp. mint extract
- ◆ 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- ◆ 9 drops green food coloring
- ◆ Whipped cream, cherries, and fresh mint sprigs for garnish

Combine the ice cream, milk, extracts, and food coloring in the base of a blender.  
Blend until thick and creamy, about 30 seconds.

Pour the mixture into 2 tall glasses and top with whipped cream, cherries and  
mint.
