## Recipe: Cool & Easy No-Bake Easter Pie

Prep time: 10 mins Cook time: 5 mins Total Time 4 hrs. 15 mins

#### **Ingredients**

2/3 cup boiling water

1 package (4 serving size) Jell-O strawberry gelatin

- or any flavor

1/2 cup cold water

Ice cubes

1 tub (8 ounces) Cool Whip, thawed

1 graham cracker pie crust (6 ounces)



#### **Instructions**

Stir boiling water into gelatin in large bowl for 2 minutes until completely dissolved.

Mix cold water and ice to make 1-1/4 cups. Add to gelatin, stirring until slightly thickened. Remove any remaining ice. Stir in whipped topping with wire whisk until smooth. Refrigerate 10 minutes until mixture will mound. Spoon into crust.



Come see any staff member at Bell Memorial Public Library for information on how to get started.


#### Wi-Fi Hotspots!

## **New Books Coming Soon!**




The Baxters by Karen Kingsbury (Release date: April 26)


Cold Snap by Marc Cameron (Release date: April 26)
