Recipe: Silly Apple Monsters

Prep time: 5 mins Total time: 5 mins

INGREDIENTS

- 1 Green Apple
- 2 Tbsp. Peanut Butter, Nutella, or Almond Butter
- 2 Strawberries
- 24-28 Sunflower Seeds or Almond Slivers
- Edible Candy Eyes

INSTRUCTIONS

Cut the apple into quarters. Lay the apple quarters down, and cut a 1 inch wedge in the middle of the peel side of each quarter. Do not cut all the way through because you want each quarter to stay in one piece. It will look like a mouth. Cut the strawberries in slices lengthwise so that you have 4 pieces. Spread peanut butter on the bottom of each mouth, inside the cutout. Place a strawberry inside the cutout to resemble a tongue sticking out. Poke 6 or 7 sunflower seeds or almond slivers into the top edge of the cut out to resemble teeth. Serve right away!

Ingredients

- 1 - Flour Tortilla
- 1 - Peeled Banana
- 1 Tablespoon - Nutella or Peanut Butter



Instructions

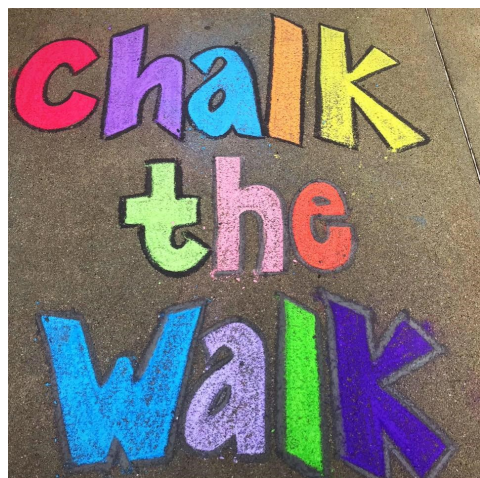

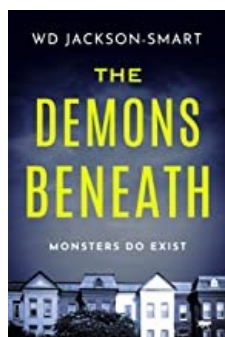

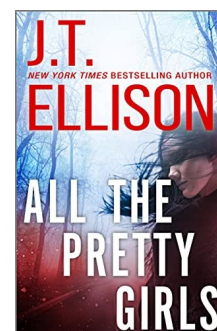
Join in on the fun, put your artistic skills to use and chalk the walks in the town of Mentone! Chalk will be provided at various locations throughout town including the Library.

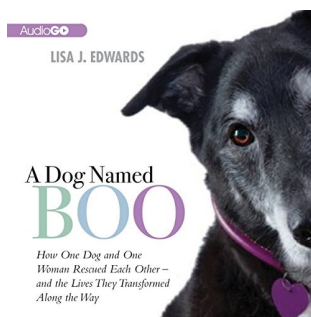

Come see any staff member at Bell Memorial Public Library for information on how to get started.

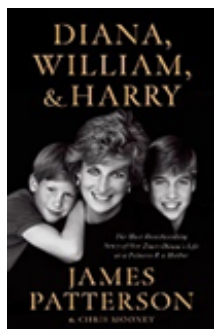
Wi-Fi Hotspots!

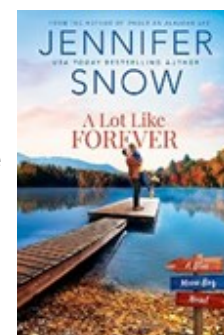
