Recipe: Memorial Day Potato Salad

Prep time: 10 mins Cook time: 20 mins Total Time 30 mins

Ingredients

1 lb. white potatoes
1 lb. purple potatoes
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/3 cup extra-virgin olive oil
1/3 cup clove of minced garlic
1 teaspoon honey
1 teaspoon white wine vinegar
1 teaspoon whole grain mustard
1 tablespoon fresh chives, chopped
To taste Salt and Pepper



Directions

Thoroughly wash the potatoes and place in a medium saucepan, cover with water and add salt. Over high heat, bring to a boil. Reduce to medium heat, cover and cook for about 20 minutes. Using a fork, check to see if the potato is soft. If it is, drain the water and allow to cool. When completely cool, peel the potatoes and cut them into quarter slices and set aside. In a small bowl, mix together the olive oil, garlic, honey, vinegar, mustard, and chives. Pour the sauce mixture over the potatoes and mix gently. Add salt and pepper to taste. Cover the bowl and chill until ready to serve.

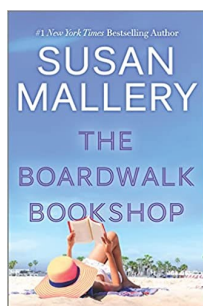
Wi-Fi Hotspots!

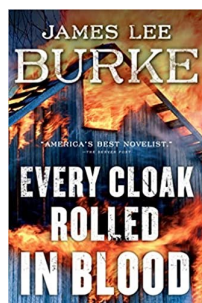
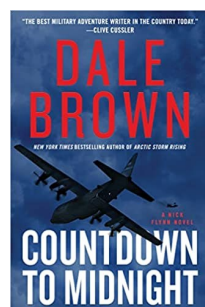
The Boardwalk Bookshop by Susan Mallery

Every Cloak Soaked in Blood by James Lee Burke

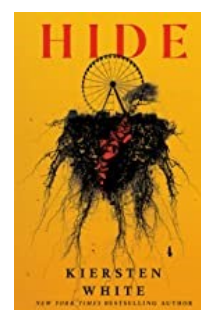

A high-stakes hide-and-seek competition turns deadly in this dark supernatural thriller from *New York Times* bestselling author Kiersten White.

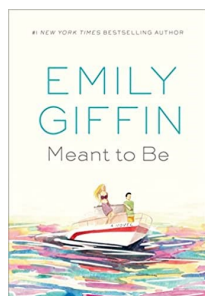
