Fun Facts About Valentine's Day

- 1. In Victorian times it was considered bad luck to sign a Valentine's Day card.
- 2. Based on retail statistics, about 3 per cent of pet owners will give gifts to their pets on this day.
- 3. About 1 billion Valentine's Day cards are exchanged each year. This makes it the second largest seasonal card sending time of the year
- 4. If you're single don't despair. You can celebrate Singles Awareness Day (SAD) instead.
- 5. Or you could pop over to Finland where Valentine's Day is called Ystävänpäivä, which translates into "Friend's day". It's more about remembering your buddies than your loved ones.
- 6. In the Middle Ages, young men and women drew names from a bowl to see who would be their Valentine. They would wear this name pinned onto their sleeves for one week for everyone to see. This was the origin of the expression "to wear your heart on your sleeve."
- 7. Richard Cadbury produced the first box of chocolates for this holiday in the late 1800s.
- 8. Over \$1 billion worth of chocolate is purchased on this romantic day in the U.S.
- 9. 73 percent of people who buy flowers on this day are men, while only 27 percent are women.
- 10. The red rose was the favorite flower of Venus, the Roman goddess of love.

Recipe: PEPPERMINT TWIST KISSES

INGREDIENTS

36 candy cane kisses or milk chocolate kisses, unwrapped

1/2 cup butter, softened

1/3 cup sugar

1/4 teaspoon salt

1 large egg yolk

1/2 teaspoon peppermint extract

1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract

1-1/4 cups all-purpose flour

4 to 8 drops red food coloring



DIRECTIONS

Freeze kisses in a covered container for at least 1 hour. In a large bowl, cream butter, sugar and salt until light and fluffy. Beat in egg yolk and extracts. Gradually beat flour into creamed mixture.

Divide dough in half; tint one portion red. Divide each half into four portions and shape into 9-in. long rolls. Place one red log next to one white log; twist gently to create one swirled roll. Roll gently until it becomes one log. Repeat with remaining dough. Wrap logs in plastic wrap; refrigerate 1 hour or until firm.

Preheat oven to 350°. Unwrap dough. Cut each log crosswise into nine slices; shape each slice into a ball. Place 1 in. apart on ungreased baking sheets. Flatten slightly with a glass.
