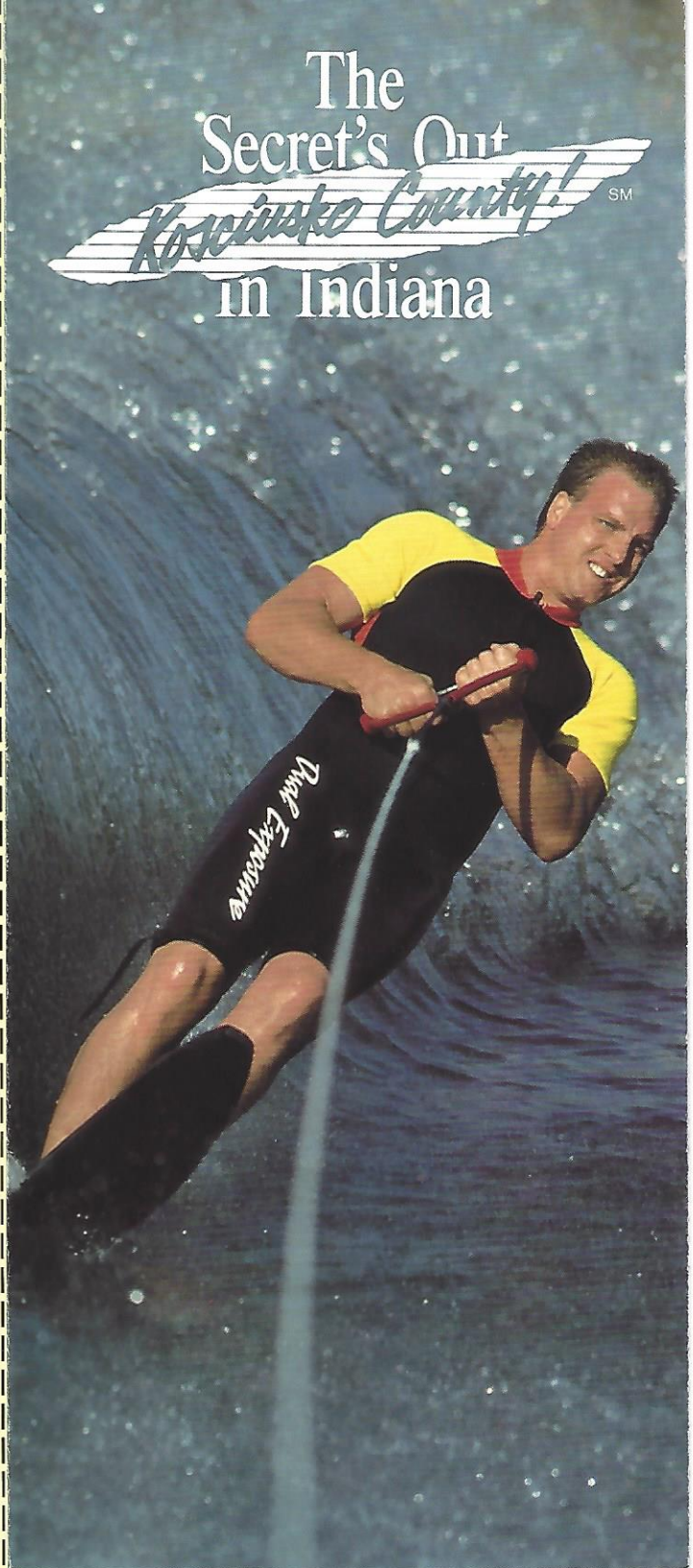

Explore Our Rich Past

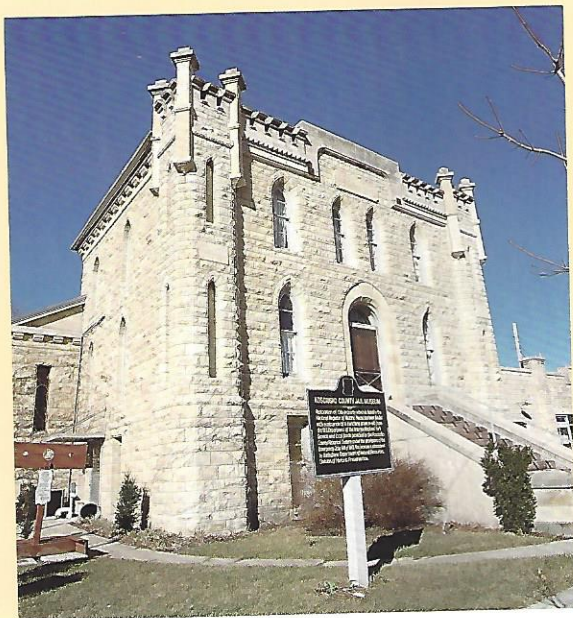
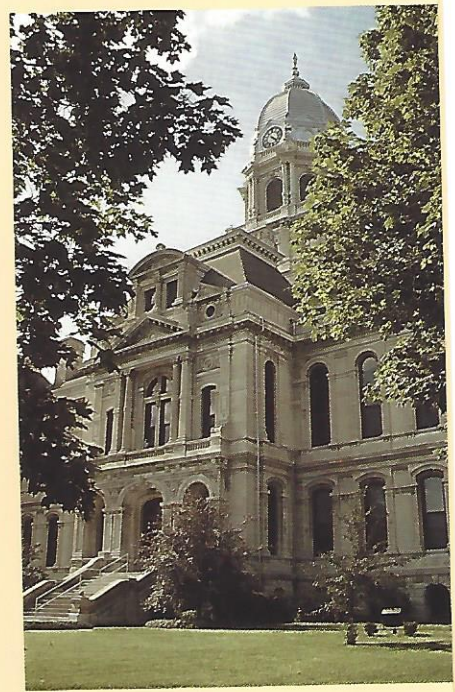
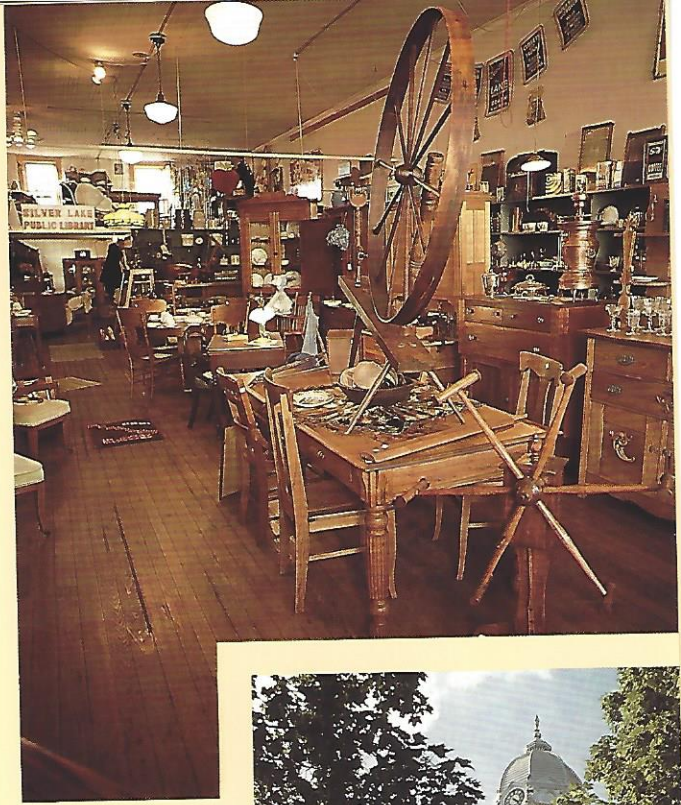
Browse through the many quaint antique shops located throughout the county, each loaded with affordable treasures.

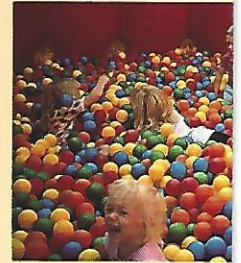
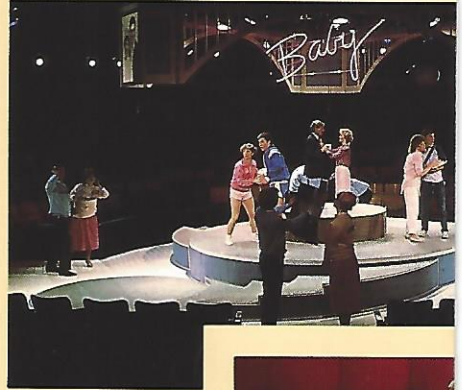
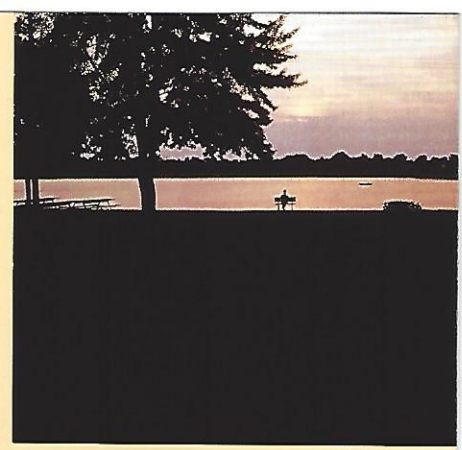
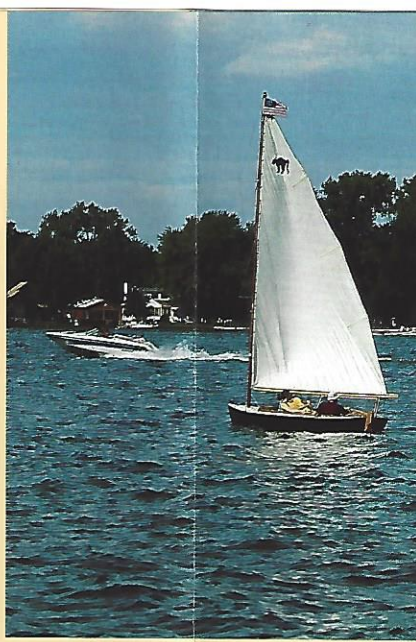
Water Sports Galore

Choose Your Own Pace

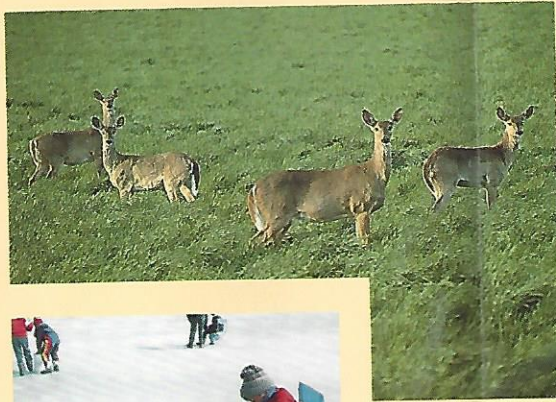
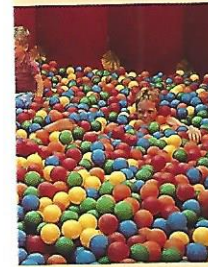

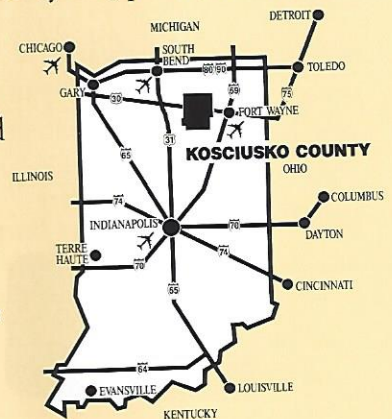
Many Lodging and Dining Opportunities
