He was a 1973 graduate of Mentone High School and worked at Winner Woodworking, Indianapolis.

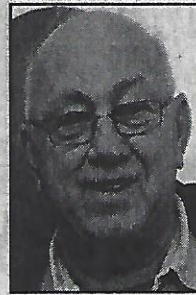
He enjoyed golfing, trips to casinos and his family. The three granddaughters were the "apples of his eyes." He also enjoyed watching auto racing.
