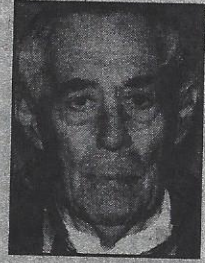


Jimmie Bryon Thomas

Dean E. Thompson, Kansas City, Mo., died Feb. 3, 2018.

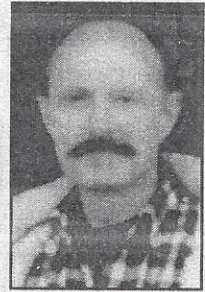
Dean was born in Claypool to Ralph and Jessie Thompson.
